



## SGGC Coronavirus (COVID-19) Screening Checklist

Updated 13 Jan 2022

In the interests of the safety and wellbeing of all that attend our club, every attendee entering the airside area of Leongatha airfield associated with SGGC's operations must **make a declaration on the sign in sheet provided on a daily basis**, before doing anything else.

Part 1 – Vaccination	Yes	No
Have you received the Covid-19 vaccinations recommended by the Victorian state government ?		
Have you provided your Covid-19 Digital Vaccination Certificate to a SGGC committee member ? <b>or</b> Have you shown evidence of your Digital Vaccination Certificate to a SGGC instructor or committee member immediately upon arrival ?		

**Note: - If you are not vaccinated in accordance with the recommendations made by the Victorian state government you are not permitted to attend the airfield or participate in any of SGGC's operations without obtaining prior approval by the SGGC committee. SGGC requires evidence of your vaccination status to be provided or sighted.**

Part 2 - Potential Exposure to Covid-19	Yes	No
Have you been a household or social contact with any confirmed cases of COVID-19 (or someone who is still awaiting a test result) in the past 14 days ?		
Are you currently required to self-isolate under Department of Health instructions ?		
Do you live with, or have you been in contact with someone who is currently required to self-isolate or self-quarantine under Department of Health instructions ?		
Are you awaiting the results of a coronavirus (COVID-19) test ?		

**Part 3a - Common Symptoms:** Do you have, or have you recently had:

• Fever or chills		
• Breathing difficulties and breathlessness		
• Cough		
• Sore throat		
• Fatigue or tiredness		
• Loss of the sense of smell or taste		

**Part 3b - Less Common Symptoms:** Do you have, or have you recently had:

• Headache		
• Nausea		
• Vomiting		
• Diarrhoea		

**If you answered Yes to any of the above questions, please do not attend the Leongatha airfield without prior discussing your situation with a SGGC committee member or the SGGC Safety Officer, Tony Hill (0423 286 341).**
